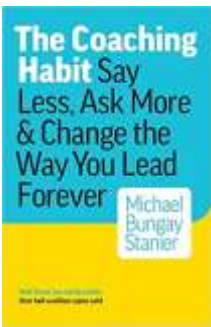


25 Songs for Your Leadership Playlist Jo Miller | CEO | Be Leaderly
