## **Job Summary**

Perform accounting functions of Neenah Foundry that are related to both general and cost accounting activities. Assist management and other departments by providing, analyzing and interpreting financial and cost data, especially related to production and inventory activities.

### **Essential Functions**

- Prepare monthly journal entries for closing and monthly budget reports.
- Responsible for maintenance of the standard cost system and inventory valuations.
- Assist in the preparation of annual overhead rates, operational budgets and inventory projections.
- Assist with quotations for new products or process improvements supporting the business.
- Prepare and monitor manufacturing production efficiencies as well as spending performances.
- Assist with external audits, financial statement information and tax return information.
- Partner with operations to develop and track key performance metrics
- Perform variance analysis and other financial analyses as requested by management, manufacturing or other departments.
- Perform other projects and tasks as assigned by manager.
